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**INTERIM APPROPRIATIONS RESOLUTION FOR JULY 1, 2026 TO JULY 31, 2026;
FY 2026-2027**

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. 159-16, when adoption of the annual budget ordinance is delayed beyond July 1, the governing board may make interim appropriations for salaries, debt service, and the usual ordinary expenses of the unit until the annual budget ordinance is adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Commissioners requires additional time to evaluate the fiscal impacts of the Pamlico County property revaluation, pending state legislation, and the establishment of an appropriate municipal tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Commissioners finds it necessary to provide for the continued operation of the municipality and its enterprise activities pending adoption of the annual budget ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Vandemere as follows:

Section 1. General Fund Interim Appropriations

The following estimated expenses are hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the operation of the Town government and its related activities for the month of July 1, 2026, in accordance with the chart of accounts previously established for the Town of Vandemere:

SECTION 3. LIMITATIONS ON EXPENDITURES

Appropriations authorized by this resolution are limited to salaries and employee benefits, debt service obligations, existing contractual obligations, utility costs, supplies, materials, and services necessary for ongoing operations, and other usual and ordinary expenses necessary to maintain essential governmental and enterprise operations.

No appropriations authorized by this resolution may be used for new capital projects or capital outlays, new programs or service expansions, or other non-routine or extraordinary expenditures, unless otherwise required by law or necessary to respond to an emergency declared in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 4. FUNDING SOURCE

Appropriations authorized herein shall be funded from available cash balances and revenues received in each respective fund during the interim period. Each fund shall remain separate and distinct, and all expenditures shall be accounted for within the department and fund from which they are appropriated.

SECTION 5. DURATION AND EFFECT

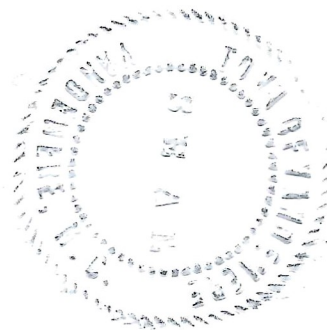
This Interim Appropriations Resolution shall become effective July 1, 2026, and shall remain in effect until July 31, 2026, upon reassessment for an August Interim Appropriations Resolution, or upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026–2027 Annual Budget Ordinance.

All expenditures made under this resolution shall be charged against the corresponding appropriations in the annual budget ordinance upon its adoption.
