The Mayor's Memoir by Judy Thaanum

The spirit of the Town of vandemere was made up by the love and care of people who lived, worked, and played. They were the people who worked long hours in the fields, then packed potatoes and cabbage in train cars to be shipped. Later came the potato and cabbage graders, making sure the trucks, which eventually replaced the train cars, were lined up and down Pennsylvania Avenue waiting to be loaded.

We had three seafood businesses: Pamlico Packing Company (owned by Earl and Ovelma Holton), McCotter Seafood (owned by Sam and Glennie McCotter), and I.J. Hudson Seafood (owned by I.J. and Ruth Hudson) all with a total of about 20 to 30 boats going and coming. What a sight to watch the boats going out the river on Sunday nights. I guess you can say we had our own flotilla! Over the years tragedy would come in to play and we would lose several boats and crewmen. This was a very sad time for everyone and hit our entire community hard! As resilient as we were (and still are), we would bounce back into action and as the boats arrived back with their catch, people all over town headed to the seafood houses to work shucking the oysters, heading and packing the shrimp, packing the fish, and picking the crabs. Then a new thing came to town...scallop boats. The Benny Rose boats had come home to share a new kind of fishing with our seafood houses. This was a good day!

vandemere also had three grocery stores. Sam McCotter, Johnny McCotter, Joe and Ivy Morris. These gave employment to several. They were not self-service at the time.

Community Cove Recipe Latkes

At Hanukkah we remember the miracle of the oil. This is why traditional Jewish festive foods of the season are fried. Although Hanukkah comes in December, Latkes are enjoyed all year long. They are easy to prepare and makes a nice change from French fries. You can also make these with sweet potatoes.

Ingredients:

-2 large or

-1 to 2 Tbs matzah meal (or flour)

equivalent smaller potatoes

-1/2 tsp baking powder

-1/2 onion (optional)

- Salt and pepper to taste

-2 large eggs

- Vegetable oil for frying

Directions:

- 1. Grate potatoes and onions together into a bowl.
- 2. Add the baking powder and matzah meal (flour) until the potato and onion are all coated.
- 3. Add the (eggs) and mix well.
- 4. Drop by large spoonfuls into hot oil in a heavy pan. Fry until brown, keep warm and crisp in oven at 300 degrees, then drain well on paper towels.
- 5. You can multiply the recipe to feed more or use as a main dish.
- 6. Top the pancakes with sour cream or yogurt or applesauce. Children often love these with ketchup.


